The Texas Brigades is a wildlife education and leadership development program. Each camp is 5 days. The camps are designed to teach life skills and increase knowledge of wildlife and habitat management. It is a fun, intensive, hands-on experience!

## Who puts on these camps?



The Texas Brigades is a non-profit, 501(c)(3) organization. The camps are put together by a dedicated group of volunteers from various government agencies, non-profit organizations, businesses, and individuals interested in teaching youth about the great outdoors.

Funding for the Brigades is provided by many donations and grants from businesses, foundations, organizations, and individuals.

## Why should I go?

You will learn a lot about wildlife and wildlife management, as well as develop your leadership, team-building, and communication skills. This camp will help you no matter where life takes you.
